Magazines are located in the back of the library. Current issues are on display and are in call number order. If you lift up the metal shelf, you will find back issues from the past year. Older issues are housed above the journal shelves, also in call number order.

Current newspapers are hanging up on the side wall in the library. Back issues are kept for ten days and are located at the front desk.
